

## PCORI Projects Involving Nurses

### RESEARCH AWARDS

As of the Spring 2015 PCS cycle, PCORI has funded 35 projects with close connections to nursing. Three categories of nursing projects exist. First, 12 projects were led by a principal investigators with a nursing degree. Second, 10 projects included nurses in key roles, such as delivering interventions or coordinating care. Third, 17 projects mentioned nurses as members of the care or research team.

These three categories of nursing-related projects are not mutually exclusive. Four studies were both led by a nurse investigator and also involved nurses in a key or team role. The 35 nursing studies are listed in the table below.<sup>1</sup>

Through the [Eugene Washington PCORI Engagement Awards](#) (Engagement Awards), PCORI offers competitively-awarded funding to improve the awareness and knowledge of CER and PCOR, the preparedness of non-research members of the health care community to participate in CER and PCOR, and the development of novel dissemination and implementation pathways. Separately, the [Pipeline to Proposal](#) program offers small awards to help jumpstart novel CER/PCOR research partnerships between patients, stakeholders and researchers. As of March 10, 2016, PCORI issued 10 Engagement Awards and 11 Pipeline to Proposal awards to nurse-led teams.
